Trained Logger Certified (TLC) Incentive payments can be paid to forest products businesses only after an eligible TLC logger who conducted the work signs this TLC Incentive Assignment of Payment form. Forest products businesses that directly employ the TLC logger working on the logging job, as opposed to subcontracted loggers, are exempted from this requirement.
