WHAT IS TLC®?

Trained Logger Certification (TLC®) is a voluntary program to promote safe, productive, and sustainable timber harvesting. TLC® is administered by New York Logger Training to recognize loggers who receive education in three core areas of knowledge and skills:

- 1) Chainsaw Safety, Operation & Productivity (Game of Logging I)
- 2) Best Management Practices, Forest Ecology & Silviculture
- 3) Adult First Aid/CPR

To maintain TLC® status, loggers acquire three Continuing Education credits over the three year certification period (that's only one course per year!), in addition to maintaining a current First Aid & CPR certification.

BENEFITS OF TLC® IN THE NYC WATERSHED

TLC® loggers are eligible for the following benefits and incentives:

- ✓ \$5.00 per MBF premium for loads delivered to participating mills (see list).
- ✓ Free roadside TLC® job-site sign to advertise your services. Call the WAC Forestry Program at 607-865-7790 x112 for more information.
- ✓ Completing four levels of the Game of Logging® through TLC® can help loggers insured through the New York Lumbermen's Insurance Trust Fund qualify for a 10% discount and provide proof of OSHA compliance.
- ✓ Bonus payments from the WAC Forestry Program for Best Management Practices used in watershed timber harvests:

- ✓ Free Sample BMPs : geotextile fabric, silt fencing, open-top pipe culvert, rubber belt deflector, and biodegradable bar/chain oil
