



Option 1: Environmental Center & Reservoir Tour

Clearpool Education Center (day & overnight trips)

Programming: Clearpool offers seasonal & public school discounts, contact Zoe Fonseca for details at 845-225-8226.

Day rates for each student and each teacher/chaperone are:

- \$25 per student
- \$10 per teacher/chaperone

You also pay for each facilitator working with your group (1 facilitator for every group of 12-15 students).

- Facilitator half-day rate (3 hours): \$150 per facilitator
- Facilitator full-day rate (6-hours): \$240 per facilitator

For overnight trips: cabins that hold 24 students and 4 chaperones are available at a rate of \$1260 per cabin per night.

Meals: You may choose to bring your own bagged lunches or buy meals from the Clearpool kitchen.

- Breakfast: \$6.50 per person
- Lunch: \$10.00 per person
- Dinner: \$13.00 per person

Nursing: You must either bring your own nurse or pay for the use of the Clearpool nurse during your visit at the rate of \$55/hour.

Bus Rates:

Bus costs will vary depending on the type of bus (yellow school bus or coach), distance traveled and time of year.*

- For high school groups traveling less than 2 hours, consider hiring a yellow school bus: \$500-1000/bus.
- For elementary and middle school groups traveling 1.5 hours or more, consider hiring a coach bus: \$1000-1500/bus.
