BMP REPAIR & REPLACEMENT PAYMENTS (DUE TO NATURAL DISASTERS) (Large Farms, Small Farms, East of Hudson)

When BMPs are damaged or destroyed due to natural acts of God or other factors beyond the control of the Landowner and/or Producer, the Watershed Agricultural Council will provide repair and replacements for certain practices pursuant to the following three categories:

- 1. Funding for replacement or major repair of BMPs that consist of capital improvements to real property will be the responsibility of the Watershed Agricultural Council.
- 2. Funding for replacement or repairs of BMPs that consist of production practices and farm equipment will be the responsibility of the Landowner and /or Producer.
- 3. Annual operating practices will require no replacement or repair.

*The Watershed Agricultural Council will not provide payment for the repair or replacement of BMPs that are damaged or destroyed due to the negligence of the Landowner and/or Producer, their employees, agents or subcontractors working for the Landowner and/or Producer.
