This document reflects the change planners discussed and agreed on 4/15/14 with regard to Standard 382: Fence.

The following logic remains as reference regarding the waste storage facilities.

“Suggested flow of logic in selecting BMP names and codes for Waste Storage facilities:

1. If the BMP is a stand alone uncovered waste storage facility then select one of the four NRCS 313 code options.
2. If the BMP is a stand alone covered waste storage facility then select WAC 3050.00 or 3050.01
3. If the BMP is a combination of Heavy Use Area Protection and Waste Storage Facility then select one of the four WAC options whether it be covered or uncovered for this combination BMP.”

- 313.00 Waste Storage Facility – Concrete
- 313.02 Waste Storage Facility – Glass lined
- 313.03 Waste Storage Facility – 3 wall, concrete floor
- 313.05 Waste Storage Facility – 3 wall, gravel floor
  
- 382.00 Fence – identify type in description, ie: High Tensile; Woven Wire; Board; Barbed Wire; Exclusion (add EX in code column)

- 561.00 Heavy Use Area Protection – Gravel
- 561.01 Heavy Use Area Protection – Concrete
- 561.02 Heavy Use Area Protection – Asphalt
  
- 634.00 Waste Transfer – Gravity
- 634.01 Waste Transfer – Pressure System
- 634.02 Waste Transfer – Pre-Fab Tank

## BMP Code References

The purpose of these codes is to sort the annual workload, and track BMP types. Codes shall be entered as capital letters on all WFP-2s in the "Code" column, and will be reflect as part of the BMP number.

C	CREP
RE	Re-enrollment – CREP
CP	CP30
EX	Exclusion Fence
M	Modification (existing completed BMPs)
EM	Emergency Modification (ranks higher than M)
R	Repair
ER	Emergency Repair (ranks higher than "R")
RR	Repair and Replacement (BMPs that have exceeded their lifespan)
ERR	Emergency Repair and Replacement (ranks higher than R&R)
OE1	Owners Expense – must be individually identified, starting with #1
PH1	Place Holder - must be individually identified, starting with #1
ENMC	Enhanced Nutrient Management Credit
MTC	Manure Transportation Credit
FR	Flood Repair (must include flood year in description)
