INVASIVE SPECIES OBSTRUCTION REMOVAL

The purpose of this guideline is to determine the need for obstruction removal of invasive species along fence lines that are beyond the normal Operation & Maintenance (O&M) of an approved BMP.

- 1) For the purpose of this guideline the invasive species list will be identified by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation - Title 6 of the New York Code of Rules and Regulations (NYCRR) Part 575 Prohibited and Regulated Invasive Species Express Terms information website <http://www.dec.ny.gov/regulations/93848.html>
- 2) Landowner/Producer(s) that have one or more of these invasive species that have excessively grown into the fences would be eligible for further review by the WAP Managers.
- 3) Excessive growth of invasive plants would have a minimum of 30 feet of continuous growth along the fence line and into the fenced area. This would be considered beyond the normal O& M.
- 4) Obstruction Removal (NRCS practice code 500) BMPs approved by the WAP Managers will be added to the Landowner/Producer(s) WFP-2. This practice will be limited to 1 occurrence per WFP.
- 5) Obstruction Removal BMPs shall be linked with the fence BMP(s) where applicable and bid as one project. No partial implementation of the project by the Landowner/Producer will be allowed.
