



Option 1: Environmental Center & Reservoir Trip

Teatown Lake Reservation (day trips only)

Programming:

Choose one or more program to fit your learning goals and schedule. Program rates depend on length of time:

- 1.5 hour programs: \$9 per student
- 3 hour programs: \$18 per student
- Teachers and chaperones are free

Course Options:

Consider the following watershed forestry themed programs. Teatown will customize programs to meet your needs:

- All grades: Our Home in the Watershed (can be adapted for all grade levels)
- Elementary: Maple Sugaring, Pond Study, Trees are Terrific, Exploring Ecosystems, It's All About Water
- Middle School: Stream Study, Maple Sugaring and Climate Change
- High School: Forest Dynamics, Stream Study, Maple Sugaring and Climate Change

9:30am	Arrive Croton Gorge Park	Croton Gorge Park, 35 Yorktown Rd, Croton-On-Hudson, NY 10520 (bus parks at park entrance, walk into park)
9:30-11:00am	New Croton Reservoir Dam tour	Start at the base of the enormous dam and spillway then walk through the woods to the top of the dam to view the 19 billion gallon New Croton Reservoir. Learn about the construction and function of the reservoir and the importance of the surrounding watershed forests.
11:00-11:30am	Drive to Teatown Lake Reservation	1600 Spring Valley Rd, Ossining, NY 10562
11:30-11:45am	Arrive at Teatown, unload, bathrooms	
11:45-12:15pm	LUNCH	
12:30-2:00pm	Teatown 1.5 hour program	
2:00-2:15pm	Bathrooms, load buses	
2:15-4:30pm	Depart & drive back to school	

*Bus rates shown here are approximate and are for guidance only.

Bus Rates:

The cost of each bus will vary depending on the type of bus (yellow school bus or coach), distance traveled and time of year.*

- For high school groups traveling less than 2 hours, consider hiring a yellow school bus: \$500-1000/bus.
- For elementary and middle school groups traveling 1.5 hours or more, consider hiring a coach bus: \$1,100-\$1,600/bus.

Meals: You must bring your own bagged lunches to Teatown Lake Reservation.
